## Academic Curriculum

Seminar series including topics such as management of dental trauma, medical emergencies in the dental office, endosseous implant placement, dental ceramics, practice management. Residents will rotate in General Dentistry, Operative Dentistry, Endodontics, Periodontics, Oral Surgery, Exodontia, Anesthesia, Emergency Medicine, and ENT. Additionally, residents will work with Prosthodontist, Pediatric Dentist, Orthodontist, Oral Facial Pain Specialist, Oral Pathologist, and Oral Radiologist. Residents will gain experience in both traditional and digital workflows and use of a variety of dental materials.
